

In January, 1994, the WEAC Council 21 UniServ, previously staffed by Bob and Mary Arends, reopened as a Special Project and was named Northeast Education Council. Dee Simmons was hired as the new UniServ Director, and Renee Ison was hired in March, 1994 as Associate staff.

On September 1, 1995, Northeast Education Council officially became Northern Tier UniServ-East when they merged with WEAC UniServ Council No. 18 and Chequamegon United Teachers to form the Northern Tier UniServ.

In March, of 1997, Dee Simmons resigned to take a job with the Oregon Education Association. NTU hired Carol Nelson from Osseo, Wisconsin to fill the role of UniServ Director for Northern Tier UniServ-East.

During Carol's tenure she organized the Forest County Deputies Association. They remained with NTU-East on a trial basis for approximately two years and then returned to the Wisconsin Professional Police Association.

From 1995-2002, the office in Crandon was housed in two different locations, the first on Lake Avenue, and the second on Pioneer Street. On March 1, 2002, the office was consolidated with the NTU Rhinelander office and relocated to Rhinelander.
